Dear Karen Hunt (Otty Lake Assn),

The Ontario Government is bringing forward Bill 66. This Bill would give municipalities the ability to create "Open for Business" zones where a variety of critical environmental protection policies - including wetland, species at risk, and source water protection - would not apply to industrial and commercial development. If implemented in the A2A corridor, Bill 66 could have a serious negative impact on the ecological values and connectivity that make the corridor a unique and important feature for wildlife and our own quality of life.
