The Friends of the Tay Watershed have announced the recipient of their annual Water Guardian Bursary for 2018. The presentation was made to Juliet Kennedy on Saturday, August 18th, in a ceremony at the Association's annual Watershed Discovery Day at the Perth Farmers' Market. Miss Kennedy is a graduate of St. John Catholic High School in Perth. The \$1000. bursary will help her continue into her 3rd year of the Environmental Science Program at Queen's University in Kingston.

Bursary criteria require the applicant to demonstrate a passion for, and dedication to, our environment. The nomination committee was impressed by Juliet's comprehensive knowledge of environmental and water issues and by her expression of passion to pursue further study in this field.

Every year, since 2011, the Friends of the Tay Watershed have extended an invitation to students at local high schools, and, recently, university students who attended a local high school, to submit applications for this bursary. Candidates wishing to apply should watch for notices from the Association next February in local papers and high schools for application requirements.
