

Bursary Opportunity for Tay Watershed Graduates

It's a piece of good news in this time of pandemic stress. The Friends of the Tay Watershed Association are pleased, once again, to announce the provision of a \$1,000 bursary. And because this is our 20th anniversary year, the Friends are prepared to present a second bursary of \$1,000 if sufficient applications warrant it.

The application process is not onerous. If it takes a student one hour to complete the application, that is a wage rate of \$1000/hour. That's pretty good wages at a time when jobs are scarce.

Being a bursary as distinct from a scholarship, this opportunity offers the student financial assistance based not on marks, but on a passionate interest in the environment and the sustainability of our water resources. Show us why and how you care about the environment.

The 2020 Water Guardian Bursary is open to a graduating student or an alumnus of a Tay Watershed high school pursuing post-secondary studies that could enhance the environment and water sustainability.

Notices and application forms have been sent to the guidance councillors at each of Smiths Falls Collegiate Institute, Perth and District Collegiate Institute, St. John Catholic High School in Perth and the Granite Ridge Education Centre in Sharbot Lake. These dedicated teachers have undertaken to pass the information on to their graduating students.
